Solis, a diocesan-wide 40-day Prayer for Life began December 14 and will end with a Mass for the Unborn on **January 18** at 6:30p in the Cathedral of the Madeleine. Parishes, families, and individuals are requested to pray the following prayer for the end of abortion and for respect for the dignity of life:

 Patroness of unborn children, we implore your intercession for every child at risk of abortion.
 Help expectant parents to welcome from God the priceless gift of their child's life.
 Console parents who have lost that gift through abortion, and lead them to forgiveness and healing through the Divine Mercy of your Son.

 Help us never to see others as burdens.
 Guide our public officials to defend each and every human life through just laws.
 Inspire us all to bring our faith into public life, to speak for those who have no voice.
